## PAYING YOUR ANNUAL SCHOOL FEES

Through our secure online payments portal, we've made it easy for you to select one of the following payment plans:

- A single payment by Monday, 3 February 2020**
- Four equal instalments (Feb, Apr, Jul and Oct)**
- 10 Monthly instalments (Feb – Nov)**

The College requires families to have chosen a payment plan by Monday, 20 January 2020. If you expect difficulty in meeting this deadline please contact our debtors team by sending an email to [finance@moriah.nsw.edu.au](mailto:finance@moriah.nsw.edu.au).

Please do your best to keep your account current. Accounts more than 16 days overdue will incur a late payment administration fee of \$110. If a payment plan becomes 23 days overdue, the College may charge interest at 4% p.a. on the outstanding amount overdue. Interest charges will be effective from, and backdated to, the date the amount was due to be paid.

## CREDIT AND DEBIT CARD SURCHARGES

The online payment portal accepts VISA, MasterCard and American Express. There is a 1.0% surcharge for VISA and MasterCard and a 1.10% surcharge for American Express. These surcharges are collected by the College and paid over to the credit card companies.

## ADDITIONAL FEES

Additional fees are payable for subject-specific levies and compulsory camps. Extra-curricular activities will appear as a separate item on your fee statement.

## PSG REBATE

The College charges the \$950 security levy per student to help recover the cost of providing security at the College. The College also operates the Parent Safety Group (PSG) and participation in the roster is expected of all families. Through additional roster participation you can qualify for a \$300 per student rebate to offset against your fees. ## TECHNOLOGY LEVY

The Technology Levy for Years 2-12 is used to offset part of the cost of maintaining and enhancing information technology resources and infrastructure.

## WITHDRAWING A STUDENT FROM THE COLLEGE

Families considering withdrawing a student from the College are encouraged to make an appointment with the Head of School or College Principal to discuss options for their children. One term's notice is required for withdrawal. Less than a full term's notice will result in a charge of one term's fees for each child. Two terms' notice is required for withdrawal from Year 6 into 7.
