FAMILY LIAISON OFFICER

Part-Time Position (3 days per week)

An opportunity has recently become available for a caring, empathic and highly skilled individual to support the wellbeing & learning of students with a disability (Early Learning - Year 12).

This vital position reports to the Head of Education Support to support students with a disability and their families to access programs and services in and outside of the College. In addition, s/he will successfully guide the collection of data on effectiveness of adjustments & interventions (behaviour & learning) for students with a disability.

The ideal candidate will have relevant tertiary qualifications and experience in working with children with a disability and their families. A background in social work or counseling with a focus on inclusion support is also essential.

To be considered for this position, s/he will ideally have:

- Experience in family and community liaison preferably in a school setting or with clients of a similar age to school-age children
- Experience developing partnerships between parents, students and staff that foster a strong sense of family and community spirit
- The ability to deliver information sessions for parents on available supports, transitions or behavioural strategies,
- Outstanding communication and presentation skills, both written and verbal
- Personal and professional discretion and confidentiality essential

All appointments will be based on merit selection without reference to the religion of applicants.

An empathy with the ethos of our Modern Orthodox Jewish Day School is essential.
