An opportunity has emerged for a dynamic and engaging Stage 3 classroom educator, with the skills to structure a rich inspiring and targeted learning environment for students of all abilities. This role will be responsible for the delivery of a vibrant, literacy, numeracy and inquiry curriculum that considers dynamic student data and student needs. The successful candidate should ideally have the skills to purposefully and effectively integrate design thinking and digital technology, into a combined inquiry learning and explicit teaching context.

Required knowledge, skills and attributes:

- Provide high quality teaching and learning programs and activities that are indicative of a thorough understanding of personalised learning and the role data plays in informing pedagogy and practice.
- Experience with inquiry-based education and intentional teaching to provide developmentally appropriate, purposeful practice.
- Utilise positive education and wellbeing practices to guide students to strengthen their relationships, enhance resilience, promote mindfulness and wellbeing.
- Foster student agency and an effective use of spoken language.
- Possess well developed collaboration and interpersonal skills with both students and adults.
- Experience in responding to contemporary research, trends and initiatives in accordance with educational best practice.
- Demonstrate a passion to participate in the co-curricular life of the College.
- An understanding of educational adjustments required to cater for individual student needs for both high potential/high performing learners as well as those with additional learning needs.
- Empathetic to the Jewish and Zionist ethos of the College.
