SENIOR COOK

This role will be responsible for cooking and baking, including preparing and creating food, ensuring cleanliness of the kitchen and managing stock supplies. You will be responsible for safe and appropriate practices in relation to hygiene.

GENERAL SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Experience in catering / event management or community catering is advantageous
- Experience with monitoring wastage in the kitchen
- Knowledge and understanding of kashrut advantageous
- Experience in working in a kitchen or hospitality environment
- Experience with managing a kitchen and small team
- Experience with maintaining stock when required
- Knowledge of WHS guidelines
- Food Safety certification or the willingness to obtain such certification
- Able to efficiently run the canteen when required – experience in this is necessary

All appointments will be based on merit selection without reference to the religion of applicants but an empathy with the ethos of our Modern Orthodox Jewish Day School is essential.

Any offer of employment will be subject to background checks and child protection screening.
