PAYING YOUR ANNUAL SCHOOL FEES

Fees are payable as a **direct debit** arrangement from your bank account or debit/credit card in one of the following ways.

- entire year in advance** (single payment by Monday, 1 February receives a 2% discount) or
- by the term** (four equal installments due on the first day of each new term month: 1 Feb, 1 Apr, 1 July, 1 Oct) or
- monthly** (10 equal installments from the 1 Feb to 1 Nov)

Through our secure online payments portal in [eLY](#) please select one of the above payment plan options. The College requires families to have chosen a payment plan by **Monday, 18 January 2021**.

Overdue accounts will incur a late payment administration fee of \$110. In addition, the College may charge interest at 4% p.a. on any outstanding amount to the College.

CREDIT AND DEBIT CARD SURCHARGES

The online payment portal accepts VISA, MasterCard and American Express. There is a 1.0% surcharge for VISA and MasterCard and a 1.10% surcharge for American Express.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Additional fees are payable for subject-specific levies, compulsory camps and excursions. Extra-curricular activities will appear as a separate item on your fee statement.

*OPT-IN COVID RELIEF DISCOUNT

Recognising the impact Covid-19 has had on many families financial circumstances, the College is offering a once-off 3% discount on net fees for families that require the extra support. Families can opt-in for this discount when selecting a payment plan in the online portal, with no additional information required. The discount is calculated on the total net fees, including Additional Fees and Fee Assistance. Therefore, the discount per the fee table is a guide, and the actual discount offered, may differ.

SECURITY LEVY AND PSG REBATE

The College charges the security levy per student to help recover the cost of providing security at the College. The College also operates the Parent Safety Group (PSG) and participation in the roster is expected of all families. TECHNOLOGY LEVY

The Technology Levy charged is used to offset part of the cost of maintaining and enhancing our information technology resources and infrastructure to continue providing a quality offering.

WITHDRAWING A STUDENT FROM THE COLLEGE

Families considering withdrawing a student from the College are encouraged to make an appointment with the Head of School or College Principal to discuss options for their children. **One term's notice is required for withdrawal.** Less than a full term's notice will result in a charge of one term's fees for each child. **Two terms' notice is required for withdrawal from Year 6 into 7.**
