PAYING YOUR ANNUAL SCHOOL FEES

Fees are payable as a **direct debit** arrangement from your bank account or debit/credit card in one of the following ways:

- entire year in advance** (single payment by Monday, 2 February 2026 receives a 2% discount) or
- by the term** (four equal instalments due on the first business day of each new term month: 2 Feb, 1 Apr, 1 July, 1 Oct) or
- monthly** (10 equal instalments on the first business day of each month from Feb to Nov)

Through our secure online payments portal in [eLY](#) please select one of the above payment plan options. The College requires families to have chosen a payment plan by **Wednesday, 14 January 2026**.

A late fee payment, which includes returned direct debits, will incur a late payment administration payment fee of \$110 (inclusive of GST) on each occasion. Continuation of enrolment/s for each year is conditional on a payment plan being selected with fees for both current and prior years being paid. Refer to our [Enrolment Policy](#). Consistent non-payment of fees may result in notice being given to suspend enrolment/s until payment of fees has been resolved and may result in a termination of enrolment.

CREDIT AND DEBIT CARD SURCHARGES

The online payment portal accepts VISA, MasterCard and American Express. There is a 1.0% surcharge for VISA and MasterCard and a 1.30% surcharge for American Express.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Additional fees are billed and payable each term for co-curricular activities and camps, subject-specific levies, and excursions and appear separately on your fee statement. Refer to "Fee Overview" tab in your eLY payment portal for your transaction history. The College reserves the right to at its sole discretion amend your monthly direct debit payment to recover overdue additional fees.

SECURITY LEVY AND PSG REBATE

The College charges a security levy per student to help recover the cost of providing security at the College. The College also operates the Parent Safety Group (PSG) and it is expected

that one member from every K-12 family volunteers for at least four PSG shifts per year (limit of one shift per family per term). There is a security levy rebate of \$450 per student, for families attending all four PSG shifts. More information can be obtained by emailing psginfo@moriah.nsw.edu.au
